From Junction 9 of the M3:

At the roundabout follow signs for the City Centre. At the traffic lights turn left and then immediately right in to Bar End Industrial Estate. Winchester Vineyard can be seen straight ahead.

From Winchester City Centre: Follow Chesil Street all the way along, until reach traffic lights. At this point there is a Petrol Station on the right. Go straight on at the traffic lights, then immediate right, turning in to Bar End Industrial Estate. Winchester Vineyard is straight ahead
